



How to Safely Stack Containers

Align Evenly

Stack containers squarely and fully aligned so they interlock as designed. This helps maintain stability and reduces the risk of sliding or tipping.

Close Lids & Doors

Make sure lids and doors are fully closed and secured before stacking to prevent damage to hinges, latches, and container walls.

Balance Weight Equally

Distribute weight evenly inside each container. Balanced loads help containers stack properly and reduce added stress on corners and bases.
